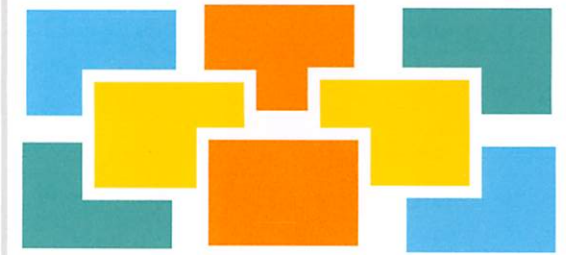
### Our Family Caring for Yours

## Adult Dental Care Emergency Visit

*Age: up to 49 years of age*

### Monday-Thursday

*On a first come first serve basis*

Only **three** emergency walk-ins at exactly  
7:30 a.m. (not after set time)

or

Only **three** emergency walk-ins at exactly  
12:30 p.m. (not before/after set time)

### Friday

Only **three** emergency walk-ins at exactly  
7:30 a.m. (not after set time)

Scheduled patients with appointments and  
patients of record with emergency have  
priority.

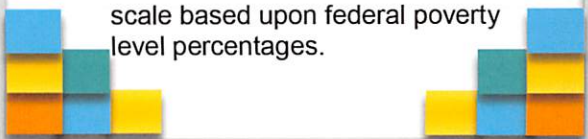
**Waiting period varies between  
30 minutes and 4 hours.**

**A complete evaluation is required at time  
of emergency walk-in visit. Prescriptions  
are provided per doctors discretion. If  
necessary, a following appointment will be  
scheduled (extraction only).**

#### Are you eligible for dental services?

Not everybody is eligible to receive  
dental services at the Department  
of Health in Collier County. The  
dental clinic works with a financial  
scale based upon federal poverty  
level percentages.



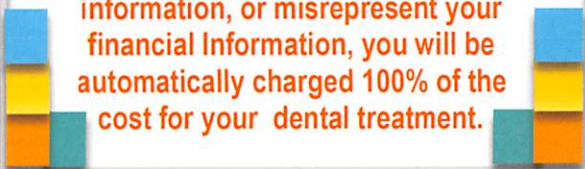
## Eligibility Requirements

- Picture ID
- Proof of Income
- Self-Employed: Notarized letter stating last two months of gross earnings and business expenses. You must bring a copy of your most recent federal tax return for business.
- Current utility bill with service address of where you live (for example: water, light, gas, or cable bill)
- Pregnant: Proof of pregnancy with expected delivery date

**If you or any of your household  
members receive any of the  
benefits listed below, please bring  
proof with gross dollar amounts:**

- Any Social Security income, child support received, or paid child care expense
- Letter from Department of Children and Family (cash assistance statement/food stamps)
- Workers' Compensation
- Unemployment \*You may be asked to apply for benefits at the Department of Children and Families

**If you don't provide any income  
information, or misrepresent your  
financial information, you will be  
automatically charged 100% of the  
cost for your dental treatment.**
