- Recommendation from current principal/supervisor
- Must hold a Florida Educational Leadership Certification
- Successfully passed the Florida Education Leadership Exam (FELE)
- Completed application and three (3) years of satisfactory evaluations (Final Evaluation score 66 or higher)
- Fulfilled at least two (2) years as a teacher leader (Team Leader, Department Chair, Academic Coach)
- Rubric score of 85% or higher on entrance interview and data performance task [LINK to Rubric](#)

- Present professional learning to faculty and complete self-reflection
