March 9, 2021 for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade ELA

March 10, 2021 for 4th grade Math

March 11, 2021 for 3rd and 5th grade Math

March 25, 2021 for 5th grade Science

PME will be using the State Adaptive Monitor Tool

Testing includes 24 questions minimum while monitoring student progress, up to 31 questions.

Testing will be 80 minutes in length and allow any special accommodations for students.
