

Dr. Rebecca Merhar reported that there is an increase in the number of students at PME and along with this increase new additional staff.

VPK is new to PME this year There are 3 different VPK subgroups; IBI PreK, VPK, and PreKD

Currently there are 701 students at PME

- VPK/ IBI PreK/ PreKD has 24 students
- Kindergarten has 119 students
- 1st Grade has 112 students
- 2nd Grade has 106 students
- 3rd Grade has 103 students
- 4th Grade has 119 students
- 5th Grade has 118 students

School Improvement Goals (SIP) - Are a state requirement that is based off testing data, to set goals, create a plan of action and monitor student progress.

It challenges students to achieve their highest potential by having a strong educational foundation.

	There are 3 major goals to increase the student gain scores.
	Reading Gains 59% in 2019 / 50% in 2021
	Math Gains 70% in 2019 / 58% in 2021
	Math Overall Gains 80% in 2019 / 73% in 2021
	Christina Davidow asked if there was a decline in scores due to the pandemic.
	Dr. Rebecca Merhar reported that there is an unknown loss percentage and further information can be gathered by evaluating prior year scores.
	Amanda Masino asked if the testing data would be relevant due to transitioning to the Best Standards Testing.
	Dr. Rebecca Merhar reported that FSA testing will continue into 2022 and the data will be reviewed and compared.
