<p>AGENDA ITEM 1</p>	<p><b>QBA 1 Data/District Data Dialogue</b>  Melissa Alamo reviewed the current QBA1 Data. This is the comparative data from the prior year to current.  There was a decrease in scores for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade. Staff have reviewed the results and are making adjustments to provide extra support.  3<sup>rd</sup> Grade scored proficient in all areas and had a 35% increase in ESE.  The QB data last year showed a 36% proficiency and this year increased to 71% proficient.  ELL showed an 17% increase</p> <p><b>PME compared to the District</b></p> <p><b>ELA</b>  2<sup>nd</sup> Place for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade  1<sup>st</sup> Place for 4<sup>th</sup> Grade  2<sup>nd</sup> Place for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade</p> <p><b>Math</b>  3<sup>rd</sup> Place for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade  1<sup>st</sup> Place for 4<sup>th</sup> Grade  2<sup>nd</sup> Place for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade</p> <p><b>Science</b>  2<sup>nd</sup> Place for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade</p> <p>Melissa Alamo reported that Staff will also be monitoring K-2<sup>nd</sup> taking a closer look and making adjustments as needed.</p>
<p>AGENDA ITEM 2</p>	<p><b>Acceleration Lab</b></p> <p>Christianne Arthur is in charge of the Acceleration Lab at PME. It is open 7:45-8:20 every Monday-Thursday. This computer lab is available for the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade students that may need extra practice with academics. The focus is on improving/increasing SIP goals, providing support for students and working with ALEKS and USA TEST PREP.</p> <p>Tuesday and Thursday Mornings for <b>5<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>  Wednesday Morning for <b>4<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>  Volunteer opportunities are still available.</p> <p>Lauren Wesson asked if the lab was for all students or just focusing on the lower percentile  Melissa Alamo responded that it allows for extra time and practice to keep students on track while providing support. <p>AGENDA ITEM 3</p>	<p><b>Guests/Volunteers on campus</b> Melissa Alamo reported that only Academically Connected Volunteers are allowed on campus.</p> <p>Sean Smith asked when they would be allowing other types of volunteers on campus Melissa Alamo responded that the time frame is still unknown and pending instruction from the district</p> <p>Literacy Week begins Jan 24-28, 2022. The first annual Academic Fair will be on January 28, 2022 and will allow for Volunteer opportunities. More information to come regarding Academic Fair.</p> <p>Melissa Alamo spoke about encouraging students to have healthy eating habits. <p>AGENDA ITEM 4</p>	<p><b>Sharpen the Saw Event</b> Melissa Alamo discussed “PBIS” which influences and rewards students for positive behaviors.
