1. Welcome and Introductions: Present—Brian Castellani, Ken Vila, Sue Castleberry, Gabriel Kohn, Ariel Pechokas
2. Approval of August Minutes: Ken Vila made the motion to approve the August Minutes and was seconded by Gabriel Kohn. All in favor.
3. Social Emotional Learning (SEL)—October Videos: Dr. Castellani shared the OES process for sharing the short district videos on the morning news. October topics include relationship skills and friendship. Maker Spaces has been a huge success in the media center and encourages students to problem solve and work together. The welcoming feeling of the media center was commended by the group.
4. iReady Diagnostic 1: Dr. Castellani provided an update of iReady Diagnostic 1 Data and weekly performance. Our averages to date included—Percent of Lessons Passed was 81% (Tied 6<sup>th</sup> in District), Average Score was 82% (Tied 2<sup>nd</sup> in District), Diagnostic Average Percentile was 61% (Tied 5<sup>th</sup> in District). Our goal continues to be to support iReady and independent reading. The group had a good discussion about this balance at home and school.
5. Safety: Cpl. Vila discussed that he has been asking parents to show him what is in backpacks they might be carrying on campus. The SAC agrees with these checks. The partnership between all agencies in Collier County was commended.
6. Mini SIP: The Mini SIP was shared with the group and the four priorities were explained. This document will be sent to staff and will be available in the hanging folder in the front office for parents.
